
**Re: Complaint by Mr. Gábor Lukács against Air Canada

We write following receipt of the Agency's letter LET-C-A-137-2012 of September 6, 2012, whereby the Agency is requesting that Air Canada answers certain questions posed by Dr. Lukács in his reply of August 31st, 2012.

Air Canada respectfully requests an additional 8 days (until September 28th, 2012) to respond to these questions. While the review of the questions is currently underway, given the complexity of the questions posed and the extent of arguments raised (23 pages), this additional delay is necessary in order for Air Canada to provide complete answers to the questions posed by the Agency.
